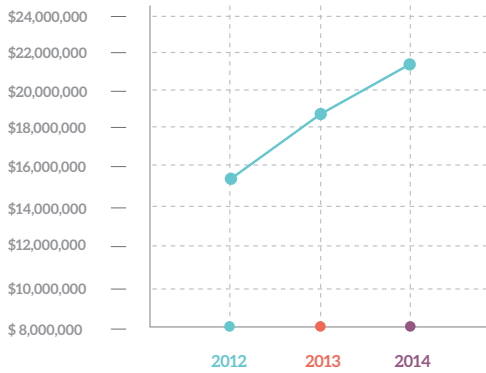

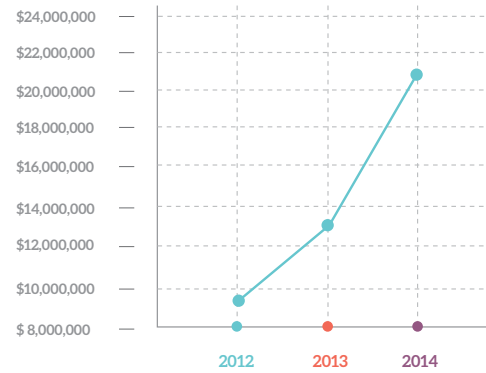

Total revenue in USD

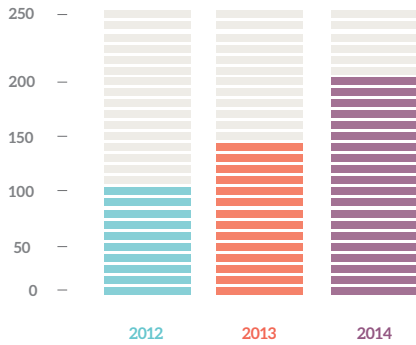


Total grants made in USD

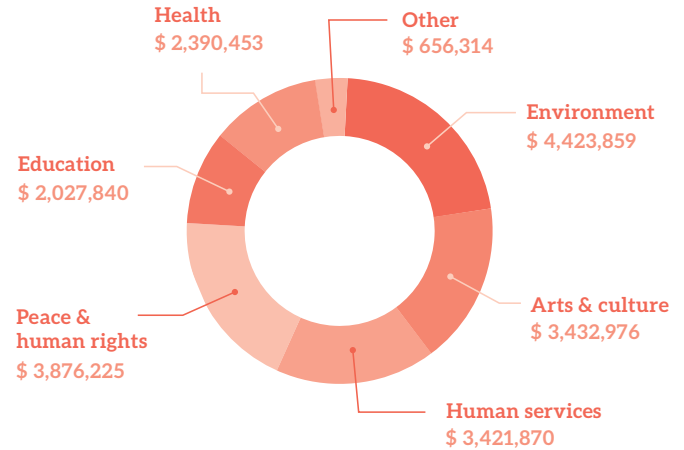


02. A CLOSER LOOK AT OUR GRANTS

Grant dollars by program area

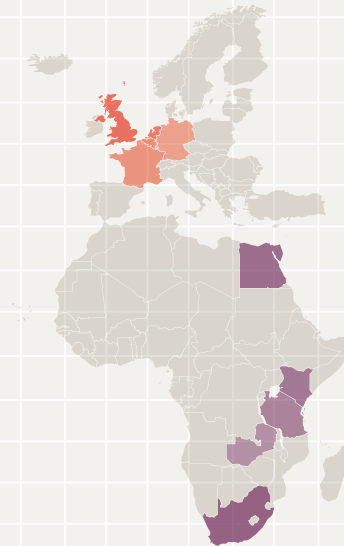

03. INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS

American Fundraising Model - European Program: Thirty one executives of European universities and cultural institutions participated in our eighth study visit to New York. Entitled “Factors Critical to Success in Fundraising and Development - The American Model”, this intensive program consists of four days of interactive discussions with the “best of the best” of New York City’s fundraising world.

American Fundraising Model - African Program: Twenty four strategic decision-makers in African higher education institutions joined us in May for the second edition of this program. Its objec-

tive is to introduce African universities to successful development strategies and enable them to learn from the longstanding fundraising expertise of their colleagues in the United States.

Corporate Philanthropy in Europe: Sixteen executives of American corporate foundations participated in our 2014 Site Visit on Corporate Philanthropy in Europe. The four-day program is organized every other year in Brussels, Belgium. Through interactive discussions with experts, participants discover how their philanthropic programs can be adapted to fit European realities.
